A call was received from a school social worker of a family she was working with. The parent called the clearinghouse and things began. A home that had been empty for some time was now filled with furniture, kitchen items, beds, and dressers. Lamps were given to give light. We are thankful that agencies in our community see us as a viable resource that helps the clients they are also working with.

In all 11 Gap Ministries were used for this family and 23 caring individuals took part in connecting with them.

Although the copay was only \$30 it still was a burden for her as she was not feeling well, and on limited income. She was met at Walgreens, we got her medication, and said a quick prayer with her.
